The meeting was called to order at 10:15AM by David Bertino. A quorum was established with four Board Members present.

- 3) David made a last call for submission of ballots from the members
- 4) David announced the total number of members present as of 10:15am: ~sixty members
- 5) David announced the total number of ballots received prior to the meeting: 133
- 6) 28 votes were submitted at today's Annual Member meeting
- 7) David announced that a quorum of the membership was present and that the meeting may proceed. Election Auditors began counting the ballots.
- 8) Approval of Annual Member Meeting minutes of April 21, 2018.
 - a. Motion made and carried to approve April 21, 2018 Annual Member meeting minutes
- 9) Update Reports

- a. Report by David Bertino, Board President, on main topics and activities for the past year.
 - i. Flood, immediate response to keep water flowing to our communities, water intake barge repairs
 - ii. Two electrical storms caused damage requiring repairs
 - iii. Litigation
- b. Report by George Burris, Corporation Manager
 - i. Anticipate water intake barge will be back in service in ~ 3 weeks after repairs complete
 - ii. 5 year plan
 - 1. #1 is generator at Water Treatment Plant (WTP) for back-up electricity
 - 2. #2 is pretreatment clarifier at WTP
 - 3. Down the list is a generator for Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) for back-up electricity
 - iii. Capacity
 - 1. Can add additional cells at both WTP and WWTP as needed
 - 2. WTP has capacity to treat 288,000 gallons / day
 - a. Today WTP actually treats ~ 40,000 gallons / day
 - 3. Present capacity likely will handle our communities' when entirely built out
- c. Review of Y2018 P&L, Y2018 Balance Sheet, and Approved Y2019 Budget by Mike Nelson, Secretary / Treasurer
- 10) Open Session awaiting voting results
 - a. Add to Board Meeting agendas improving bill pay
 - i. Third party needs to run electronic bill pay (credit card, check)
 - b. A new water intake barge was built ~Y2002
 - Y2013 Board received a grant to improve the barge which significantly increased its size and capacity
- 11) Election Results
 - Election Auditor, Janet Crow, provided David with a written report of the election results for director positions voted on by the members.
 - b. David announced the election results.
 - i. Bill Billingslev: 32
 - ii. Bill Earnest: 95
 - iii. Joe Gimenez: 96
 - iv. Rene Ffrench: 63
 - v. Patty Flunker: 58
 - vi. Mike Nelson: 134
 - One ballot was thrown out as both a business name and address were used instead of a WOWSC billing name and address
- 12) David introduced the three newly elected directors and declared them as board members to assume the position of directors immediately.
 - a. Newly elected directors: Bill Earnest, Joe Gimenez, Mike Nelson
- 13) David announced the new Board of Directors were holding a meeting to elect officers on adjournment of this meeting.
- 14) Motion made and carried to adjourn at 11:48AM
