Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:03PM by Joe Gimenez. A quorum was established with five Board Members present.

- 1) Comments from citizens and members who wish to speak on agenda or non-agenda items (3-minute limit per person)
 - a) Danny Flunker: Janet Crow has been very vocal about being on the side of the Directors in the lawsuit
- 2) REAL ESTATE COMMITTEE Receive update regarding WOWSC property in airport area. Consider and take possible action on moving forward with marketing of WOWSC property.
 - a) This item was moved to after Executive session during the meeting.
 - b) Discussion after Executive session:
 - The Board discovered a lis pendens against WOWSC's airport property placed by current lawsuit of Ffrench, Dial, and Sorgen that keeps the airport property from being sold.
 - ii) This is very odd as Plaintiffs and others have complained about the Board not selling WOWSC's airport property to pay legal fees when they have placed the lis pendens against the airport property which keeps it from being sold.

 - b) Ratepayers Appeal of Water and Sewer Increases by the WOWSC filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas;
 - c) Appeal of Attorney General ruling filed in Travis County District Court in the case of WOWSC v The Honorable Ken Paxton, Attorney General of Texas, Cause No. D-1-GN19-006219, for protection of corporate rights and privileges during ongoing litigation including potential settlement of same.
 - d) Pending Public Information Act requests.
 - e) The Board may go into Executive Session under Texas Government Code § 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney) to discuss Item 3.
